Dear BCUOMA Service Providers,

Re: Changes to the Return Collection Facility Program Incentive Rate

Effective January 1st, 2017, the Return Collection Facility incentive for consumer returns will change to \$0.30/L for oil and antifreeze from \$0.10 for oil and \$0.15 for antifreeze.

For facilities that collect only consumer material (e.g. depots) the new rate applies to all the material collected.

For facilities that self-generate oil and antifreeze through their business (e.g. service stations, lube shops) and receive consumer returns, the incentive applies only to the portion of material dropped off by a consumer. These facilities will need to provide evidence of the volume of consumer returns either by providing a consumer drop off log sheet (see sample on BCUOMA website) or by subtracting the service change volume from the collector Bill of Lading or using another method approved by the Executive Director

To be eligible for the new RCF incentive facility owners should:

1. Register (or re-register) for the RCF program using the new Registration Form in the Service Providers section on the BCUOMA website - <http://bcusedoil.com/recycling-collection-facility/>
2. Use the new incentive Claim Form on the BCUOMA website - <http://bcusedoil.com/recycling-collection-facility/>

BCUOMA will continue to provide the current RCF incentives (\$0.10/L for oil and \$0.15/L for antifreeze) for the first three months of 2017, to March 30th, 2017, as a transitional measure for facilities that self-generate oil and antifreeze and have not registered for the new program.
